

## Whiteboard feature

Whiteboard is a feature available to candidates while taking an OnVUE exam. It gives candidates the option to work through items visually by entering notes or drawing shapes. Access this feature anytime while testing by clicking the eraser icon at the top of the screen.



### What tools are available?

This feature allows candidates to:

- Enter text and draw shapes and lines
- Change the stroke size of lines, the fill and background colors of shapes, and the size and font of text
- Erase or clear the working space to start something new

**Pan Tool**  
View tool for horizontal and vertical movement across the drawing space

**Eyedropper Tool**  
Color detection tool that identifies the color of any pixel on the screen
